The Commission wishes to advise that it may only recognize continuing education courses and offerings that meet the minimum standards established by the Appraiser Qualifications Board (AQB) of the Appraisal Foundation. The AQB requires that credit toward the continuing education hour requirements for appraisers may be granted only where the length of the educational offering is at least two (2) hours. Further, pursuant to Code of Maryland Regulations 09.19.02.04 D., the Commission may not approve a continuing education course unless the course it is at least 2 hours in duration. Given none of the segments of your conference were at least 2 hours in duration, the Commission is unable to grant credit for any portion of the conference.
