The Education and Licensing Division has evaluated THE COUNSELORS OF REAL ESTATE's application for continuing education elective course approval for *The Counselors of Real Estate 2018 Annual Convention*. However, the course cannot be approved as submitted.

Specifically, 21 NCAC 58H .0406 and .0407 have definite elements that are required for the approval of proposed elective courses:

58H .0406(c) The application for original approval shall be accompanied by a copy of the course guide, which shall include course objectives, learning objectives for each topic, a timed outline, instructional methods and aids to be employed, and all materials that will be provided to students.

**58H** .0407(a) Continuing education elective courses shall:

- (1) cover subject matter related to real estate brokerage practice and offer knowledge or skills that will enable brokers to better serve real estate consumers and the public interest;
- (2) consist of at least four hours of instruction;
- (3) offer four continuing education credit hours;
- (4) include handout materials for students that provide the information to be presented in the course...

The attachment included with the application form (simply the convention agenda) does not satisfy these rule requirements; therefore, this application is inappropriate for approval as a NC real estate continuing education elective course.
