

Jill has over 40 years of institutional real estate investment experience and currently serves as Chair of the Mass PRIM Real Estate and Timber Committee, Member of the New York State Teachers Real Estate Committee & Commissioner - Boston Zoning Commission. She also previously served on the Board of the UW Foundation (2007-2020) and held the role of Chair of the UWF Investment and Alternatives Committees. Jill retired from BlackRock in June 2008, where she held the position of Managing Director with various portfolio management, real estate investment and leadership roles at BlackRock Real Estate as well its predecessors including President and CEO of GE Capital Investment Advisors.
