Academic. Jack P. Friedman is a graduate of the Bronx High School of Science in New York. He has a BBA degree in Finance from Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem N.C., an MBA in Accounting from Pace University in New York, and a PhD in Business Administration with a major in Real Estate from Georgia State University in Atlanta Georgia. He meets several continuing education requirements to maintain professional designations, licenses, and expertise.

Real Estate Designations and Licenses. Friedman is a State Certified General Appraiser with licenses in Illinois, Texas, Florida, Georgia and Kentucky. Academic Employment. He has been an assistant professor at Georgia State University (1971-1976), an associate professor at the University of Texas at Arlington (1976-1978), and a full professor at Texas A&M University in College Station Texas, in the Finance Department and Texas Real Estate Research Center (1979-1990). He held the Julio S. LaGuarta Professorship for a five year term (1985-1990), and was senior research economist for six years.
